PRMN-616H The Great Preachers and Pulpits of New York City: Exceptional Influence of Exceptional Preachers. New York City is a world center for finance, fashion, entertainment, exemplary and corrupt politics, and—without a doubt—profound spirituality, influential churches, and great preaching. Our class will visit 6 churches where exemplary preachers preached during the 20th century. While on site in those churches we will study some of the intricate details of the sermons that made the selected preachers notable. Because of the nature of our visitation we will also be able to take in the breathtaking architecture in many of these houses of worship. The preachers whom we study will represent a variety of theological positions as well as a variety of denominational affiliations. **Class will meet the Thursday evenings of Feb. 4, 11, and May 12 in King of Prussia; trip to New York City will take place Tuesday-Thursday, March 15-17 (during Reading Week).** No prerequisites.
