THE OFFICE OF SUPERVISED MINISTRIES AT PALMER SEMINARY

- The Office of Supervised Ministries (SMO) offers students the following programs:
 - Ministry education in clinical settings through <u>Clinical Pastoral Education</u> (CPE) and <u>Clinical</u> <u>Pastoral Care</u> (CPC)
 - Ministry education in a church-based setting or other Christian service agency through <u>Theological Field Education</u> (TFE)
 - Connections to ministry opportunities/employment and denominations through <u>Placement</u>

THE OFFICE OF SUPERVISED MINISTRIES AT PALMER SEMINARY

- In this orientation we are focusing on the clinical internship programs (CPE and CPC)
- Students pursuing a Master of Divinity (MDiv) earn 4-7 credit hours for internships
- This requirement varies for students in dual-degree programs, and those pursuing a Master of Theological Studies (M.T.S.), Christian Counseling track
- Internships are congregational/agency and clinicalbased

CURRICULUM FOR MDIV STUDENTS (78 CREDITS)

• Students on the Pastoral Leadership Track must take:

- \circ TFE 1A and TFE 1B
- CPC (full unit) or CPE (half-unit)
- Students on the Adaptive Leadership Track may select:
 TFE 1A and TFE 1B
 - CPE or CPC
- For students on the Adaptive Leadership Track (entering in fall 2018 and beyond):
 - o TFE 1A and TFE 1B

O May select CPE or CPC CPE/CPC Orientation Spring 2021

CURRICULUM FOR M.T.S. IN CHRISTIAN COUNSELING STUDENTS

- If you are taking CPC for your summative requirements, note that the requirement is 2 courses of CPC:
 - In two (2) types of clinical settings
 At two (2) locations
- You will receive 3 credit hours for each course

IS IT TIME TO BEGIN CPE OR CPC?

- To determine whether it is the right time for you to begin, consult your Academic Advisor
- There are a number of options for completing your internships which will vary by student and their degree program and track
- Consider your specific needs as you understand them now and as you consider your life beyond seminary
 - This will help you as you select internships
 (clinical and pastoral) to meet your graduation requirements

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Clinical Pastoral Care:

Clinical Pastoral Education: SUPV532

- Nationally accredited program with chaplains certified by ACPE and CPSP.
- Completion results in professional certification. (Intern is qualified to advance to the second tier of chaplaincy training.)
 CPE/CPC Orientation Spring 2021
- SUPV522
 Sites with an onsite staff chaplain. Qualifications reviewed and chaplain approved by the SMO.
- Program created and accepted for completion of requirements at Palmer Theological Seminary.

COURSE PREREQUISITES

- To begin CPE or CPC, you must:
 - Have completed at least 18 credit hours
 - Have completed Foundations of Pastoral Care and Counseling or Intro to Pastoral Care or Holistic Habits for Ministry
 - Have completed Nurturing Spiritual Life and Character I or Spiritual Formation or Pastor as Person
 - Have completed Systematic Theology and Ethics: Vision of Community or Systematic Theology and Ethics: Reign of God

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Clinical Pastoral Education

• Full CPE unit

- Minimum of 400 hours
 - 300 clinical hours
 - 100 educational hours
- Will earn 6 PTS credit hours
- Half CPE unit
 - Minimum of 240 hours
 - 180 clinical hours
 - 60 educational hours
 - • Will earn 3 PTS credit hours

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Clinical Pastoral Care

- All CPC work
 - Minimum of 200
 hours
 - 150 visitation hours
 - 50 instructional hours
 - Will earn 3 PTS credit hours

THE PROCESS: GETTING STARTED

- Consult your Academic Advisor to:
 O Plan your academic schedule
 - Determine your readiness for the clinical internship requirement
- Consult your denomination or ordaining body

 Are there any specific requirements for ordination?
- For CPE, <u>begin your search **the year prior** to</u> <u>beginning your internship</u>
- For CPC, <u>begin your search at least the semester</u>
 <u>prior to beginning your internship</u>

THE PROCESS: FINDING A CLINICAL SITE Clinical Pastoral

Education

- Information, applications, etc. are available online at <u>www.acpe.edu</u> and <u>www.cpsp.org</u>
- Contact site and discuss process with chaplain
- Obtain application and pay all necessary fees

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Clinical Pastoral Care

- Locate site and negotiate terms of educational experience with approved chaplain supervisor
 - Site directory available from SMO
 - New sites must be approved by SMO
- Contact site and discuss details of internship with chaplain

• No "external program" tuition

• Complete any clinical site requirements, such as background checks or immunizations, and ask about associated fees

SAMPLE REQUIREMENTS FROM A SITE

- Relevant health and immunization records
- A tuberculosis test
- Criminal background checks and clearances^{*}
 Orientation and training

*Requirements set by the clinical site must be completed before the intern is allowed to begin the internship. Interns may not have access to patients/clients/residents served by the clinical site until the requirements are fulfilled.

Ministry Opportunities/Examples

- Penn Medicine and Lancaster General Hospital CPE intern and residency program
- Phoebe Ministries Extended CPE Group

THE PROCESS, CONTINUED Clinical Pastoral Education

- Visit the SMO first to register and confirm approved site, and enroll in course with Academic Advisor and Registrar
- Begin internship as advised
- All work should be done with the chaplain
 supervisor at the site CPE/CPC Orientation Spring 2021

- Visit the SMO first to register, obtain a CPC Syllabus, confirm approved site, and enroll in course with Academic Advisor and Registrar
- Begin internship as advised
- Required assignments must be completed for both the SMO and the chaplain/supervisor at the site

THE PROCESS: FINISHING WELL

Clinical Pastoral Education

- Forward all evaluations to the SMO; end of internship evaluation(s) determine "Credit" or "No Credit"
- Forward proof of fees paid to site, if requesting reimbursement, to the SMO at end of experience
- Grade earned after receipt of all evaluations indicating satisfactory completion of requirements

Clinical Pastoral Care

- Forward evaluations and completed requirements to the SMO
- Grade earned after satisfactory completion of hours, assignments, and evaluations
- End of experience evaluation(s) and work submitted determine "Credit" or "No Credit"
